

## **NTCAT Practice Direction No. 1**

## Intervention by Director - Crimes Victims Services Unit in applications under section 48 Victims of Crime Assistance Act

- 1. This practice direction is made under section 139 of the *Northern Territory Civil and Administrative Tribunal Act* (NT) and may be referred to as NTCAT Practice Direction No. 1.
- 2. Upon an initiating application filed under rule 5 of the *Northern Territory Civil and Administrative Tribunal Rules* and made pursuant to section 48 of the *Victims of Crime Assistance Act* being accepted by the Registrar, there shall be orders, to be endorsed on the initiating application, as follows:
  - 1. The Director Crimes Victims Services Unit has leave to intervene in the proceeding and is from now on to be regarded as having intervened pursuant to section 129 of the *Northern Territory Civil and Administrative Tribunal Act* (NT).
  - 2. Despite order 1, the applicant may object to the intervention of the Director Crimes Victims Services Unit.
